Cover our cough or sneeze with a flexed elbow or a tissue, then throw the tissue in the bin.

Clean and disinfect frequently touched objects and surfaces.

How to use alcohol-based hand sanitizer

Use an alcohol-based hand sanitizer that contains at least 60% alcohol.

Supervise young children when they use hand sanitizer to prevent swallowing alcohol, especially in schools and childcare facilities.

APPLY enough product on hands to cover all surfaces.

RUB hands together, until hands feel dry.

This should take around 20 seconds.

Note: Do not rinse or wipe off the hand sanitizer before it's dry; it may not work as well against germs.
